ORGANIZATION HISTORY & STRUCTURE

The Luverne Commercial Club was organized to promote and support Luverne businesses in 1918. In 1941, the organization was renamed Luverne Civic and Commerce Association and applied for non-profit 501 C6 status under Minnesota Statutes. *Today, our official name is the Luverne Area Chamber & Convention and Visitors Bureau.* Luverne Area Chamber continues to operate under the objectives that were envisioned almost 100 years ago:

"To develop, encourage, promote, and protect the commercial, professional, financial, general business and residential interests of the City and surrounding area of Luverne; to promote the civic interests and the general welfare of the community; to extend and promote trade and commerce, and foster, develop and protect the industry and residential developments of the Luverne area."

Membership is comprised of any person, firm, association or corporation interested in the general welfare of the City of Luverne and the surrounding area.

The organization is directed by a Board of Directors who are responsible for conducting the business of the Chamber. The Board of Directors consists of twelve members elected at the Annual Meeting. Four directors are elected each year. In the case of a resignation, the Chamber Board may appoint a person to fill the seat. The membership shall elect a Board *President, Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary* at the Annual Meeting to conduct the business of the Board. The Annual Meeting is held in the month of December.

The Board appoints an Executive Director and Administrative Assistant who shall direct the day to day operation of the Chamber including the management of property, business and affairs of the corporation and shall perform such functions and duties as may be delegated by the Board of Directors and/or the President.

Luverne's Chamber is in a unique position to facilitate and support tourism in Rock County. By managing the Rock County Veterans Memorial Building, Chamber staff has the opportunity to connect with travelers from around the world as they visit the Herreid Military Museum and Brandenburg Gallery. In 2024, the building is on track to welcome more than 4,500 unique visitors.

Significant accomplishments during the 2024 calendar year:

- Coordinating two charter bus visits; three larger family reunions and two conventions
- Assisted in coordinating "Operation Homecoming" a parade and celebration welcoming the 1942 Jeep Willy that was gifted to Luverne through the efforts of Jim Brandenburg, KAHR Foundation, LACF, Rock County and LIFT
- Coordinated the second annual Veterans Banner Program
- Provided information to residents, businesses and visitors in response to an average of 8-10 phone calls per day
- Provided regular and scheduled golf cart tours of significant community accomplishment to approximately 500 people throughout the spring, summer and fall
- Provided management and coordination services for Luverne Initiatives for Tomorrow and their sub-committees which include the Destination Branding Committee, Plaza Committee, Design Committee, Dog Park Task Force, and the Open for Progress Task Force
- Hosted 4 ribbon-cuttings for new businesses
- Supported local non-profits in response to their needs such as registration assistance, event sales, development of promotional materials, marketing, and etc.
- Distributed approximately 73 hometown greeter bags to new residents
- Coordinated larger public events that brought more than 30,000 visitors to the community throughout the year
- Coordinated the Cardinal Coupon Card project in partnership with Luverne Schools
- Coordinated and distributed over 4,500 Luverne Visitor Passes to travelers
 coming to the community to drive sales to local businesses
- Responded to the needs of government, organizations, residents and visitors through the coordination and communication of services

CONVENTION & VISITORS BUREAU

The Chamber staffs the LUVERNE CONVENTION & VISITORS BUREAU. The Luverne CVB was formed by the City of Luverne to utilize locally controlled lodging tax to promote and support visitor traffic.

The CVB is controlled by an independent Committee that is comprised of members representing lodging, restaurants, retail, general business and organizations with a representative from the City of Luverne and the Luverne Area Chamber Board of Directors. This Committee makes decisions on promotional investments.

Programs they offer to increase visitor traffic include:

- Operating the Chamber as an official Explore Minnesota Affiliate Travel Information Center to serve visitors with information for local and state travel opportunities
- Digital presence on the Explore Minnesota website
- Print advertising in State, regional and national travel magazines
- Promotional advertising in the Twin Cities metro area
- Interstate billboard and Minnesota Logos advertising
- Operation of the ROLL ON LUVERNE PROGRAM (borrow a bike)
- Distribution of more than 5,000 Luverne Visitors Guides to Minnesota Travel Information Centers, Chambers & CVBs throughout Minnesota
- Assist in planning and coordinating special group tours, class reunions and family events to Luverne and Rock County (approximately 1,000 annually)
- Respond to individual requests for local information to visitors and new residents from leads generated by digital and print advertising
- The CVB assists in coordinating two community events that bring people to town; the events include: Get Hooked Ice Fishing Derby and the Ride the Rock Canoe & Kayak Trip
- Plans, coordinates and executes events, programs and services that market the Northern Tallgrass Prairie in Rock County

The CVB coordinates the promotion of Luverne and Rock County both inside and outside our borders.

The Luverne Area Chamber and CVB are honored to staff the community treasure, the ROCK COUNTY VETERANS MEMORIAL BUILDING. Opening July 18, 2009, the building is home to the Brandenburg Gallery, Herreid Military Museum and offices of the Chamber.

The Gallery is operated by the Brandenburg Prairie Foundation and features two floors of photographs by award winning, former National Geographic nature photographer and Luverne native Jim Brandenburg. Proceeds from Gallery sales and fundraising are dedicated to saving the fragile Northern Tallgrass Prairie Refuge—Touch the Sky Prairie.

The upper two floors of the building house the Herreid Military Museum. The museum features the story of men and women from Rock County who served this great country from the Civil War through today. The museum is the vision of philanthropists Warren G. Herreid and Jeannine M. Rivet who remodeled the former Rock County Sheriff's Office, Home and Jail into this state-of-the-art museum.

The building is open 52 hours per week free of charge for residents and visitors to enjoy. Approximately 6,000 people visit the building for tours and special events each year.
